Process: Applicant must submit application during Parties at the Plaza hours (5-8pm) to designated promotion official. Space is limited to the first 50 applications. Completed applications only, will be accepted, they must include:

- Occupation
- Career/personal achievement
- Education Level

- Age verification via license
